In the “heart” of the Memorial there are **four old goods wagons**, like the ones which set off for Hell.

Between December 1943 and January 1945 at least **twenty wagons left from here, they were packed with Jews** and political opponents.

Along the Wall of the Names there is a huge display on which there are the names of the 774 people deported from here: in white the victims and in yellow the few survivors (22). The names are pointed out in rotation, to give them back their dignity.
